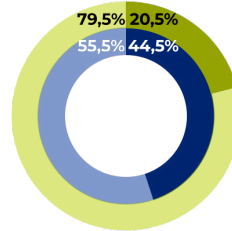

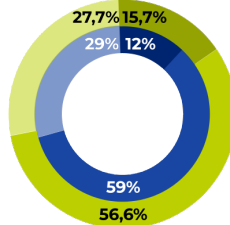

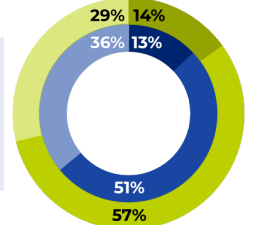
Do you know the Caribbean Climate Change Adaptation Network - Agriculture & Food?

Rate yourself on natural crop protection strategies



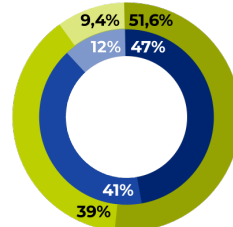

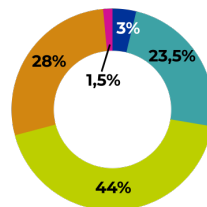

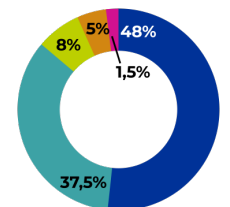

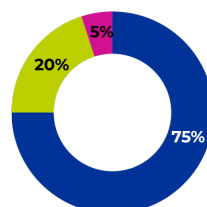
