

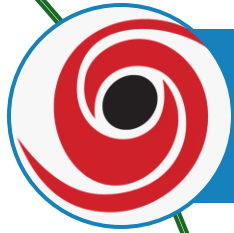

Why A Roadmap For Disaster Response?



Increased frequency and intensity of catastrophic hydrometeorological hazards



Member countries need to be in a constant state of readiness and preparedness to address disasters



Need for greater efficiency in stakeholder coordination to avoid duplication of efforts and maximize the use of scarce resources



Need for clearly defined roles and responsibilities by all stakeholders
