# Saint Vincent and the Grenadines

## Main contributions during 2013

- St. Vincent and the Grenadines now has new institutional mechanisms for the development of the pork industry through IICA's intervention and provision of direct technical support and training to technical officers of the Ministry of Agriculture in the use of the CADIAC methodology for participatory dialogue and action, the provision of support to stakeholders in the formation of a Dialogue and Action Platform, the development of a (draft) action plan for the industry and the formation of a Pork Producers Organization.
- The St. Vincent and the Grenadines Network of Rural Women Producers have a new instrument designed to strengthen the institutional structures and transform its operations as a result of IICA's development and delivery of a four-year (2013-2016) Medium Term Plan for the Organization.
- Twenty-two members of the Women in Agriculture for Rural Development are positioned to benefit from the development of a new diversification alternative in vegetable production as a result of the work of the Institute in the formalization of a project proposal for vegetable production, funded by the Government of Australia, assistance in the implementation of the project and training of recipients in vegetable production.
