Note: Article 70 of the Rules of Procedure of the IABA provide that quotas are “due on the first day of each fiscal year.” Additionally, Resolution IICA/JIA/Res.414 (XIII-O/05) establishes that quotas for the current year become past due if not paid by June 30 of the year, indicating “During the current year, a Member State shall retain the status it had as of December 31 of the prior year, provided it makes a payment equal to the current year’s quota by June 30 of the current year. Failure to make that payment by June 30 will result in an adjustment of status.”
